The DSOSN was founded in 1987 by a group of parents of children diagnosed with Down syndrome. Over the years, the organization has grown to become the leading voice of advocacy for persons with Down syndrome in Southern Nevada. We also advocate for the needs of persons with other intellectual developmental disabilities (IDD), including autism, and our services/programs are extended to hundreds of persons with IDD throughout Southern Nevada. We are affiliated with the National Down Syndrome Congress, National Down Syndrome Society, and Down Syndrome Affiliates in Action. We are a member of the Las Vegas Chamber of Commerce, the Henderson Chamber of Commerce, and we collaborate with other local service-providers, agencies, and organizations that provide services to members of the broader disability communities here in Southern Nevada.

The programs we provide to our members are entirely supported by donations and funds raised during our annual fund-raising events. One of our signature fund-raising events is the annual Buddy Walk, which is the coming together of families, friends, and supporters to promote and advocate for the interest of persons with Down syndrome/IDD.
